

PHOTOGRAPHY

- Participants are required to bring their own digital camera.
- Number of photographs can vary from 1 to 5.
- Participants are also required to bring their own USB cable, card reader.
- Photographs should not include any kind of vulgarity or offensive matter.
- Time limit is **one hour**.

CULTURAL EVENTS

GROUP DANCE

Group dance is an event where thoughts/emotions/themes may be expressed through a purposeful blend of dance and music.

Rules for Group Dance:

- One team per college is allowed.
- Participants per team may be 3-10.
- Time allowed per team is **4-8 minutes**.
- Props are allowed.
- Vulgar/obscene songs will lead to disqualification

FOLK DANCE

Folk Dance is an event where participants can express variety of flavor through dances of various states and cultures.

Rules for Folk Dance:

- One team per college is allowed.
- Participants per team may be 3-10.
- Time allowed per team is **4-8 minutes**.
- Props are allowed.
- Vulgar/obscene songs will lead to disqualification.

AD-MAD SHOW COMPETITION

- There shall be one team per college.
- Each team may comprise of minimum three and maximum five participants.
- The teams shall be given five minutes preparation time.
- The participating team shall be allowed to perform for **2-3 minutes**.

GENERAL RULES

1. No registration fee would be charged from participating students.
2. Only undergraduate students can compete in Inter College Competition.
3. The last date of registration for events duly forwarded by Head of Institute is February 15, 2020.
4. Participants are required to bring their college ID cards.
5. Teams are requested to report for registration in between 9.00 AM to 9.30 AM.
6. Decisions of judges will be final.

POWER-POINT PRESENTATION

- Each institution can send two teams with maximum of two participants each.
- Participants can present power-point presentation on the below mentioned themes:

LITERARY EVENTS

POETIC SYMPOSIUM

Poets play with the most powerful weapons in the world: WORDS. Poetic symposium is an event where participants can express any opinion/situation/emotion through verse.

Rules for Poetic Symposium:

- Each institution can send two entries with one participant each.
- Maximum time allowed shall be **2-3 minutes**.
- Language can be English/Punjabi/Hindi/Urdu. The participant can choose any one language.
- The poem may be self composed or work of any other poet and should be poetry not a song.
- The theme of the poem is 'Journey/safar(in Hindi,Punjabi /Urdu).
- Paper reading is not allowed.

MOCK PRESS CONFERENCE

This event is a mock rendition of a press conference wherein the participants would pose as public figures ranging from politicians to scientists to writers, singers, sports personalities or film stars to hear them speak and raise questions.

Rules:

- Each institution can send two entries with one participant each.
- The participants may choose an option from the following four categories.: **1. Sports 2. Politics 3. Entertainment 4. Corporate**
- The participant has to speak for 2 minutes portraying the personality he/she is representing.
- The participant can be asked to answer any two questions raised by fellow participants.
- Based on the Celebrity the participant can select his/her language. (Hindi, English) only.
- Obscene words, flaring comments and personal attacks are strictly prohibited. Contestants are expected to maintain decorum while they respond to the queries.

FINE-ARTS EVENTS

POSTER MAKING

- Maximum time allowed will be **2 hours 30 minutes**.
- Sheet size will be 22"x 15 "and it will be provided by the host institute.
- Topic/theme will be given on the spot. Multicolored Poster is allowed.
- Participant will bring their own required material like brushes, paints etc.

COLLAGE MAKING

- Maximum time allowed will be **2 hours 30 minutes**.
- Sheet size will be 22"x 15 "and it will be provided by the host institute.
- The event will be conducted on the spot on the given topic/subject.
- Collage has to be prepared from old magazines. Scissors are not allowed.
- Participant will bring their own related material.

RANGOLI

- Maximum time allowed will be **2 hours 30 minutes**.
- Size: (2'x2') to (4'x4) with 5% permissible variation.
- Only one medium shall be used –Poster colors/ Flower petals/ saw dust/ Pulses/ rice without pasting.
- Topic/theme will be given on the spot by the judges.
- Accessories e.g. sieve, spoon and scale etc. are allowed.

BEST OUT OF WASTE

- Maximum time allowed will be **2 hours 30 minutes**.
- Minimum 2 participants and maximum 4 participants are allowed.
- Topic will be given on the spot.
- Teams shall be responsible for arrangement of the material required for the event.

MEHNDI DESIGNING

- There shall be 2 members in each team, one for competition and other on whom to apply mehndi. Participants must bring their own material.
- Participants can apply mehndi on their own hand or any other person's hand.
- Theme will be given on the spot. Time Limit is **one hour**.

FACE PAINTING

- There can be 2 participants in a team (one for competition and other whose face is to be painted.) Participants should bring their own colors, brushes etc.
- Time limit is **one hour**.
- Theme will be given on the spot.
